

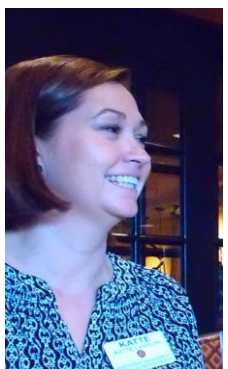
**October 15....New Rotarians for a Growing Club...Help for Shaken Babies.....**
